

Preface

The MoDeVVA workshop series brings together researchers and practitioners interested in the application of validation and verification (V&V) techniques in model-driven engineering (MDE). The main goals of the workshop are to identify, discuss, and elaborate on mutual impacts of MDE and V&V.

The 13th edition of MoDeVVA took place on the 3rd of October 2016 and was co-located with MODELS16 in Saint-Malo, France. Ten papers were submitted and seven papers were accepted for presentation at the workshop after a careful peer-reviewing process with many discussions.
