Abstract

We want it all.

Sustainable, resilient, inclusive, accessible and beautiful city districts including local production and reuse, social infrastructures, reconnecting with nature, circular solutions, publicness, social infrastructures, active engagement of artistic, cultural and creative sectors, sustainable mobility solutions etc.

That is easier said than done. Many projects start out with these ambitions, but the experts end up working alongside each other. Discipline-specific approaches are much more straightforward to implement, but they are not able to handle these complex societal challenges. In this talk, I will show examples of our projects in which we help people cooperate, inspired by the New European Bauhaus. We build cooperation frameworks as “open spaces” in which stakeholders from the public and private sector, academia and civil society can come together, discuss, test, fail, try again and eventually find good solutions for their local environment.
