Preface on the 2nd. Doctoral Workshop on Artificial **Intelligence and IT Security***

The CITA24 Doctoral Symposium is co-located with the ANSALB International Conference on Information and Communication Technologies (CITA2024) and held from June 27 to 28, 2024, at ISBA, Champs de "Foire, Cotonou, Benin (West Africa)".

The CITA24 doctoral symposium is intended to attract postgraduate researchers with a strong background in AI and IT security. It has allowed the PhD students to present and discuss their research internationally, fostering interactions between students and researchers from academia and industry.

Experienced researchers in AI, machine learning, deep learning, and computer security offered guidance to PhD students on various aspects of completing a PhD and conducting successful research. Short papers (up to four pages for technical content and one page for references) and regular papers (5+ pages), written by students and their research advisors, were collected.

Topics of Interest

The conference has called for regular research and workshop papers with a focus on the following areas of interest: but not limited to:

- AI applications
- ML & Deep Learning
- Blockchain applications
- AI Applications for eGovernance
- AI Applications for Healthcare services deliveries
- Networks Security
- IT security in AI Applications
- DeepFake Detection

The doctoral symposium received 23 papers submitted from local PhD students in this 2nd edition. Eight papers were accepted for this volume after a strong peer review process supported by international reviewers.
