Preface

These are the proceedings of the ninth Linguistic and Cognitive Approaches to Dialog Agents (LaCATODA 2024), which was held at Kyoto University, Japan on November 19, 2024 as a part of the Pacific Rim International Conference on Artificial Intelligence (PRICAI 2024) Nine papers were submitted to the workshop of which seven were accepted (six long and one short) to be presented during the workshop. The submissions were reviewed by at least two members of the program committee. Keynote talk titled "7 Pillars for the Future of AI", was given by Prof. Erik Cambria from Nanyang Technological University.

This workshop was the ninth edition of the LaCATODA series. The two first editions were organized as symposia of the AISB/IACAP conferences in United Kingdom: the first one in 2010 in Leicester, and the second one in Birmingham. From the third edition we have been co-located with the prestigious IJCAI conference: in Melbourne (2017), Stockholm (2018), Macao (2019). Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, 2020 and 2021 workshops were moved from Kyoto and Montreal to online venues. LaCATODA went hybrid at Nara in 2022 to be back to the "in person" style in 2024.

We would like to thank all authors who submitted papers, and the program committee members for their efforts.
